However, if your version is 6.1 or higher, then it is time to update your drivers. 4. This is an optional step that can be performed if your computer does not have internet access through a wire or through a wireless connection by using a CD/DVD drive to download the correct driver file. This video will walk you through the steps in installing the drivers for your Digitech USB Av Grabber in Windows 7. 1. Insert the CD in one of your computers CD/DVD drive. Note: If you are unsure which drive the CD is in, try removing it and checking to see if it shows up on another drive or in another computer. This guide uses a CD because it is faster to install this driver over a wireless connection with no internet access available. 2. Open any 'Run' window by holding down the 'Windows' key, then type in "cd" (without quotations) into the 'Open' box, then press 'Enter'.
